# Aurora District Webeloree Authorization & Release for Special Exemption of Attendance Policy

Destination: Ensign Ranch, 3551 Hundley Rd, Cle Elum, WA 98922

I acknowledge and understand the risks of Webeloree as 1).Skill & Maturity Level of all Cubs Attending Webeloree. The Webeloree program is open to all Cub Scouts in the ages 3rd, 4th & 5th grade. Noting that there are differences in the skills, maturity and energy level of the scouts, their reaction to large numbers of people attending, the Boy Scout activities and physical risks of the campground, close supervision is dictated. 2. Number of Youth Attending event. Webeloree as a program is invited to run their program on the Camporee campus. The Camporee program provides a weekend long program for Boy Scout Troops in the Aurora District and plans for 250 youth, 75 adults, and 40 staff members composed of 30 youth leaders. Considering there will be 375 persons in attendance that are not acquainted with the Cub Scout program, consideration must be taken to manage the risk to the Cub Scouts. Camporee / Webeloree does not provide staff outside of the scheduled Saturday program to monitor or watch Cub Scouts. 3. Water Risk. The camping locations for Camporee / Webeloree include water resources, i.e.: rivers, and lakes. While there are no water activities planned, consideration must be taken to keep the cub scouts supervised and safe near water. The Camporee/Webeloree program does not provide staff trained in Safety Afloat or Safe Swim Defense or Aquatics Safety.

I understand that all Safe Scouting, and Youth Protection Policies apply. Your scout may not sleep in the same tent as the requested adult listed on this application. The scout may sleep with the Cub Scout attending with this adult. If at any time, whether due to inappropriate behavior, illness or injury, if any one of the three people in this group have to leave, everyone must depart. The care of this scout can not be transferred to any other adult at any time from the departure in Seattle to the return to their home.

I approve the sharing of the information on this form with BSA volunteers and professionals who may need to know of medical situations that might require special consideration for the safe conducting of Scouting activities.

In case of an emergency involving me or my Scout, I understand that every effort will be made to contact the individual listed as the emergency contact person. In the event that this person cannot be timely reached, permission is hereby given to the medical provider selected by the adult leader in charge, to secure proper treatment, including hospitalization, anesthesia, surgery, or injections of medication for me or my Scout. Medical providers are authorized to disclose to the adult in charge examination findings, test results, and treatment provided for purposes of medical evaluation of the participant, follow-up and communication with the participant's parents or guardian, and/or determination of the participant's ability to continue in the program activities.

I understand that participation in Scouting activities involves a certain degree of risk. I have carefully considered the risk involved and hereby give consent for my Scout to participate in these activities. I understand that participation in these activities is entirely voluntary and requires participants to abide by applicable rules and standards of conduct. I release the Boy Scouts of America, the local council, the activity coordinators, and all employees, volunteers, related parties, or other organizations associated with the activities, from any and all claims or liability arising out of my Scout's or my participation, in these activities.
